Poorly managed medical waste is a silent crisis in Somalia and beyond. We help healthcare facilities move away from open burning and unsafe dumping—and toward clean, organized, and compliant waste systems.

Our services are practical, inclusive, and built to protect healthcare workers, patients, children playing near dumpsites, and even our coastal waters from toxic exposure.

Our Work Includes:

- Set up proper waste segregation using reusable, color-coded bins.
- Teach everyone—from doctors to waste handlers—how to handle sharps and body fluids safely.
- Coordinate transport and final disposal through licensed incineration sites we built ourselves.
